



The Traverse City Film Festival renovated Traverse City's shuttered historic downtown movie house, and reopened it in November 2007. The festival operates the State as a year-round, community-based, mission-driven, non-profit, volunteer-staffed movie theater.

We show the best in new movies, and a whole lot more. We've got family films on Saturday at 10 am and classic films at 11 am on Wednesdays, both for just 25 cents. We have a Monday Documentary Night Series and \$3 Friday Night Flicks offering the best in cool midnight films. And we are Traverse City's town hall, opening our doors for free community events like our Spring Break Open House, sporting events, and screenings for students. We also broadcast the Met Opera live in high definition, show holiday movies, and bring premieres and special films and mini-festivals on a regular basis.

The State was restored by the festival to serve the people of northern Michigan, and those who visit here, as a high-quality state-of-the-art movie palace. Everyone is welcome to enjoy the movies at the State in a comfortable, relaxed setting at affordable prices — to experience the movies the way they were meant to be.

## Frequently Asked Questions

### How do State Theatre Members find out about current and upcoming events?

### Are memberships tax deductible?

The State Theatre is owned and operated by the TCFF, a 501 (c) 3 non-profit organization. Contributions are tax deductible to the extent allowable by law.

### Are Friends of the Film Festival and State Theatre memberships the same thing?

Friends of the Film Festival and State Theatre memberships are separate, unrelated programs. State members contribute to the year-round theater and receive their Member benefits at the State outside of the festival period. Friends benefit during the festival period and can order festival tickets before the general public. State Members receive a membership card, while festival Friends do not.
